Minutes of the monthly conference of the District and Sessions Judge, Karimganj, Shri P. R. Kar, the Superintendent of Police, Karimganj District, Doctor Krishna Kemprai, The Joint Director of Health Services, Karimganj held on 15.03.2017:

1. The District and Sessions Judge acknowledged the receipt of the copy of memo number CRIME/IX-02/2017/2.998.3013 dated 06.03.2017, pursuant to the resolution passed in the monthly meeting held on 15.02.2017 whereby the officers in charge of the police station of the district have been directed to direct the investigating officers to ensure that medical legal examination of victim are done by a Doctor trained in allopathy including the MBBS Doctors working on contractual basis with a government hospital; to ensure that mobile number/email ID of the Doctor concerned be mentioned in charge sheets, to avail the provisions under section 357(6) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and to collect medico-legal opinion in the event, the same has been kept pending subject to further investigations like forensic examination et cetera.
2. The District and Sessions Judge also acknowledged the receipt of copy of memo number 467 dated 23.02.2017 of the Superintendent, Civil Hospital at Karimganj, along with corrigendum thereof, vide memo number 528 dated 06.03.2017 pursuant to the meeting held on 15.02.2017.
3. The Superintendent of Police, Karimganj District has given the detail of cases pending investigation in the different police station in the Karimganj district as on 28.02.2017 and has submitted that 36 cases are pending investigation because post-mortem reports have not been furnished to the investigating officer. The detail further states that 140 cases are pending at the stage of investigation for want of medico-legal report.
4. The same has been brought to the notice of the Joint Director Health, Karimganj District. On suggestion given by the District and Sessions Judge, Karimganj District that some official direction may be issued fixing
